Welcome to Life Scout. The following is a quick guide to help you along the final steps to Eagle.

Requirements for Eagle:

- 1. Active in troop 6 months
- 2. Demonstrate Scout Spirit by living the Scout Oath and Scout Law
- 3. Earn a total of 21 merit badges (13 required)
- 4. While a Life Scout, six months in one or more positions of responsibility
- 5. While a Life Scout, plan, develop, and give leadership to others in a service project
- 6. Scoutmaster Conference
- 7. Eagle Board of Review

Final Eagle Rank Steps:

- 1. **Eagle project** (from BSA Advancement Guide, chapter 9)
 - a. First, brainstorm ideas with your parents, the project should be "Helpful to Any Religious Institution, Any School, or Your Community". No minimum service hours, focus should be leadership and service. Should be more than routine care.
 - b. Present idea to scoutmaster for preliminary approval
 - c. Download fillable Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook pdf

d. Project Proposal

- i. Fill in the sections Project Proposal, using complete sentences and proper grammar.
- ii. Show the proposal to the Council Rep for a preliminary review. Make any changes requested.
- iii. After Council Rep approval, get signatures on Project Proposal pg H

e. Project Plan

- i. Fill in the Project Plan before starting the project, using full sentences.
- ii. Schedule/start the project when the plan is complete.

f. Project Report

- i. When done with the project, complete Project Report promptly to record your experiences and feelings.
- ii. Get final signatures.

2. Final Paperwork

- a. Fill out Eagle Application, including references, and give Eagle Application and Eagle Project Report to the Advancement Chair.
 - i. Advancement Chair will request letters of recommendation prior to board
- b. Write your Statement of your Ambitions and Life Purpose. (see Eagle Application, just before signature lines)

3. Eagle Board of Review

- a. The Committee Chair will schedule the Board of Review when the paperwork is returned from Council.
- b. Attend Board of Review
